The Honey Branch Regional Business Park is a public and private development partnership of Floyd, Johnson, Magoffin, Martin, and Pike Counties. Consisting of over 300 acres on a reclaimed mountaintop mining site, the park's tenants include Schlumberger Inc., an oil and gas well services company, and Consolidated Pipe, a pipe supplier to the region.
