② CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL WHILE ON BOARD OPERATING A MOTORIZED VEHICLE

③ ALL OFF ROAD VEHICLE DRIVERS AND RIDERS SHOULD FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURERS SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURES. PLEASE BE SURE THAT YOUR GEAR HAS THE APPROPRIATE EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO OPERATE ON THE RUGGA TERRAIN IN THE PARK
