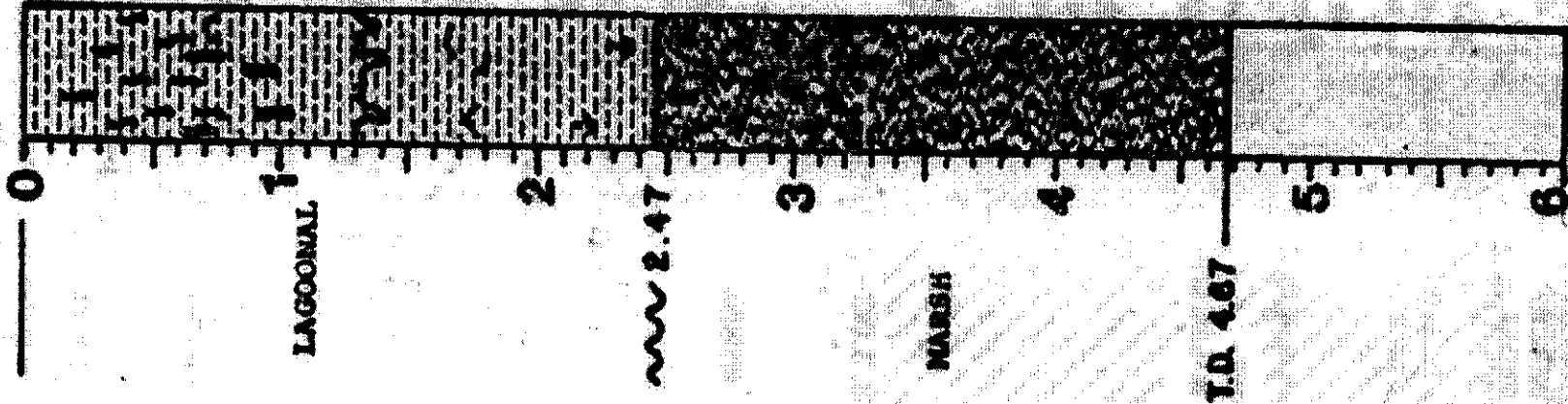

MUD; very high water content to 0.30 m, dark gray changing to medium dark gray below 0.30 m.

Abundant worm burrows 0.3-0.8 m; *CLASSELIDAE* half shell; bivalve burrows common, mud infilled.

Burrowed contact at color change to olive black.

Rare shell ghosts; *Jagella* fragment.

Compact mud; olive gray; rare detrital marsh fragments.

Sharp; non-burrowed contact.

MUD w/ in place marsh grasses; organic rich to 3.30 m; moderate brown, brownish black; color banding.

Mud-rich, dark gray laminae (1 mm) show horizontal planar and wavy bedding surfaces; dominant color medium gray with bluish tinge; olive black laminae common.
