- 25-30 Silt, brown, fine
- 30-35 Silt, brown, slightly sandy
- 35-40 Same
- 40-45 Same, sandier, returns probably not representative
- 45-50 Sand, lt. brown, fine to medium, poorly sorted
- 50-55 Same
- 55-60 Same, becoming coarser
- 60-65 Drilling easy, no change
- 65-70 Same
- 70-75 Same
- 75-80 Same
- 80-85 Same
- 85-90 Same
- 90-95 Same
- 95-100 Same, off augers: sand, fine to coarse, poorly sorted, brown and white
- 100-105 Same
- 105-110 Same
- 110-115 Same

- 120-125 Same, streak of clay at 123'
- 125-130 Same
- 130-135 Slightly harder drilling at 133'
- 135-140 Same
- 140-145 Harder drilling at 144'
- 145-150 Off augers at 145': clay, gray and brown, oxidized, silty.
