

McLaughlin notes
KF 21-38

Cuttings log: (20' rods + 5' reamer)

0-25' mix of orange-tan muddy sand
light gray muddy sand, some granules
+ on top (deepest?) dark gray-brown
muddy carbonaceous sand (peaty)

25-45' continued carbonaceous muddy sand
(as above) and light gray sandy (vl) mud

45-65' olive gray very muddy fine sand

65-85' A/A, with some fine thin dispersed
shell frags; also a few bits of light gray
& light tan mud

85-105' Sand, fr veg w/ some granules
abd shell material, and thick shells (oyster?)

105-125' more sand, and ^(mg-cg) brown
micaceous
clayey silt (more of the silt than sand)

125-145' muddy med sand w/ shell
and a few small chunks of brown m

145-165' muddy fine sand w/ fine
shell frags

165-185' slightly muddy mg-cg
shelly sand, fine thin shell fra

185-205' slightly muddy fg-mg sand
a little cg, abd larger/coarser sh
frags than above

205-225' A/A - shell frags in sand, brown
muds are clayey and platy

225-245' mg-cg sand, mostly, common
shells, a few platy frags of ^{fr} brown
clayey silt

245-265' cg sand (also mg-veg), abd
shell frags
