

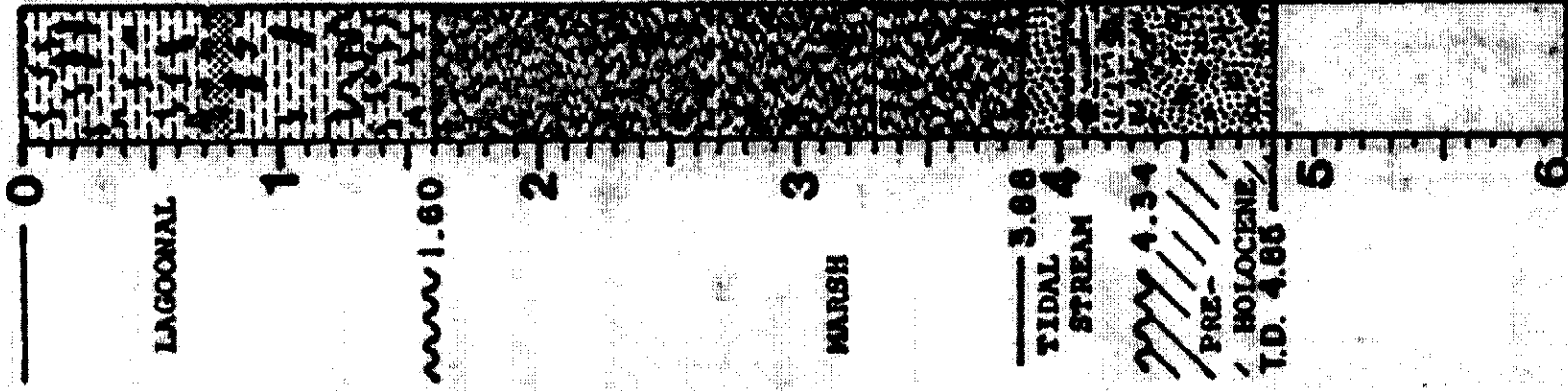

MUD; clayey SILT; dark gray and m dark gray, intense worm and bivalve burrowing; rare shell fragments.

VF SAND and MUD; 13 cm bed; burrowed; some laminations; possible distal flood-tidal delta deposition.

Burrowed color change to olive black; abundant worm burrows; detrital marsh-plant fragments.

MUD w/ in situ marsh grasses; organic-rich to 2.55 m; dusky brown, moderate brown, brownish black; color banded; laminated.

Mud-rich; dark gray to medium dark gray; 3.30 m abrupt color change to medium gray with bluish tinge; laminated.

M-C SAND; very light gray; inter-laminated.

M-F SAND, MUD and plant detritus; interlaminated.

M SAND w/ C SAND and quartz/chert PEBBLES to 3 cm; very light gray; structureless; very compact.
