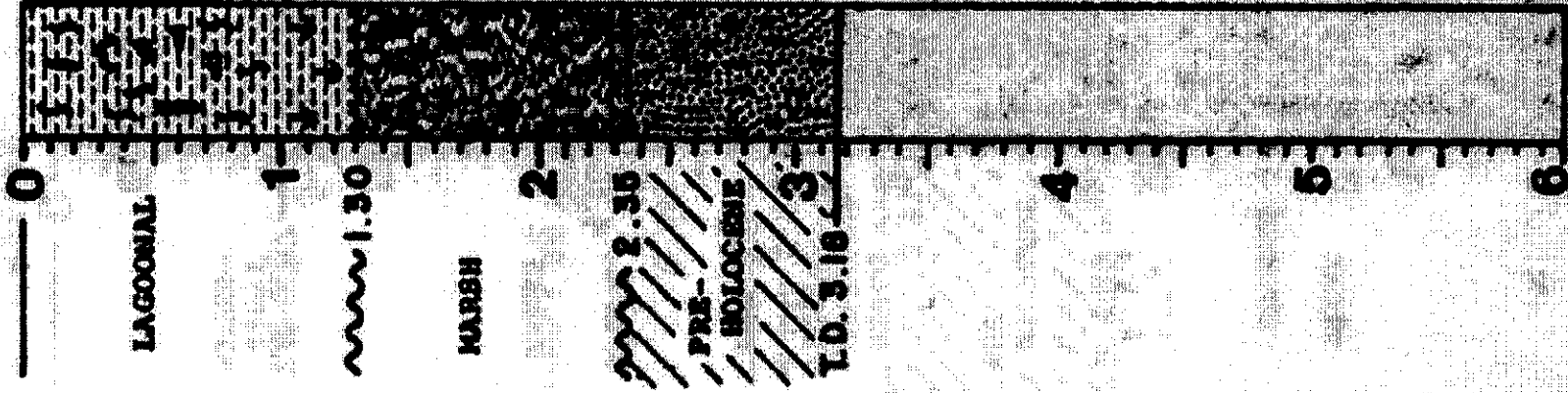

VP SAND and MUD, medium dark gray; abundant worm burrows; bivalve burrows common; ANDARA half shell (3.2 cm width); gastropod shell ghosts or chalky fragments.

Detrital marsh-plant fragments common.

MUD w/ in situ marsh grasses; alternate mud- and organic-rich units; olive black, grayish black; VP SAND abundant 1.65-2.29 m; rare bivalve burrows; no apparent primary structures.

PEAT; black; 6 cm bed.

M-C SAND, rare PEBBLES (1.4 cm max); roots and rootlets abundant decreasing with depth; structure-less; brownish black stained to 2.42 m, then brownish gray and light olive gray at core base.
