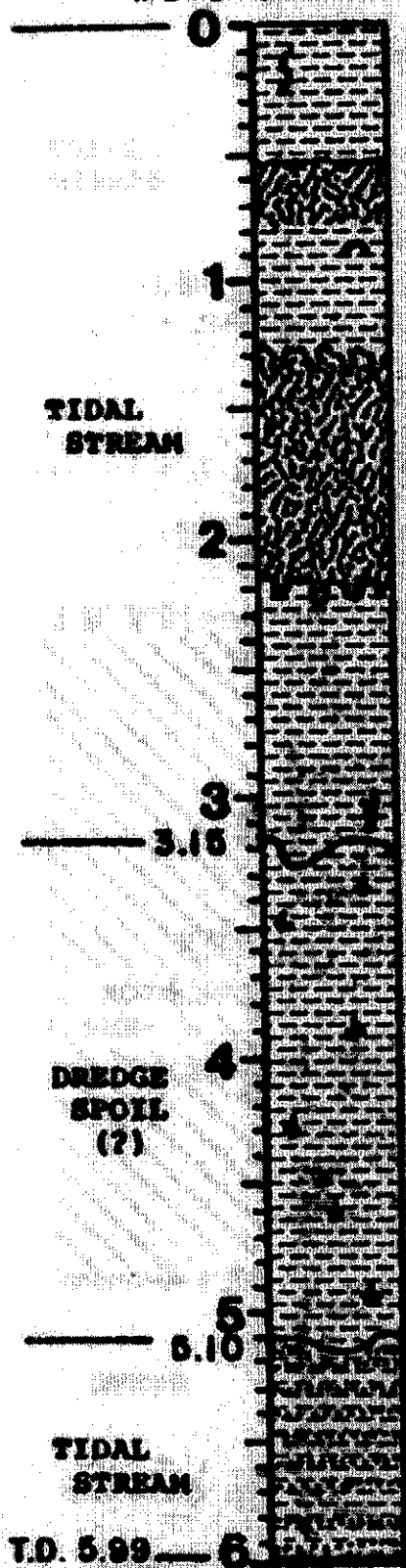

MUD; dark gray to greenish black; soft; structureless; rare worm burrows.

Abrupt color change, grayish black; plant detritus. *Tagelus* fragment.

Homogeneous mud; burrowed contact; structureless.

Detrital plant roots and rootlets; brownish black; faint laminations indicated by color changes.

MUD; compact; homogeneous; very fine-grained roots and rootlets; m dark gray; no apparent structures; 7 cm vertical twig in lower sequence.

MUD and plant detritus; very compact; cavities or "vugs" are abundant; light olive gray and pale yellowish gray beds and laminations.

Loading structure on basal contact.

Interlaminated MUD, VP-Y SAND and organic detritus; m dark gray.

Lenticular bedding common below 5.25 m.
