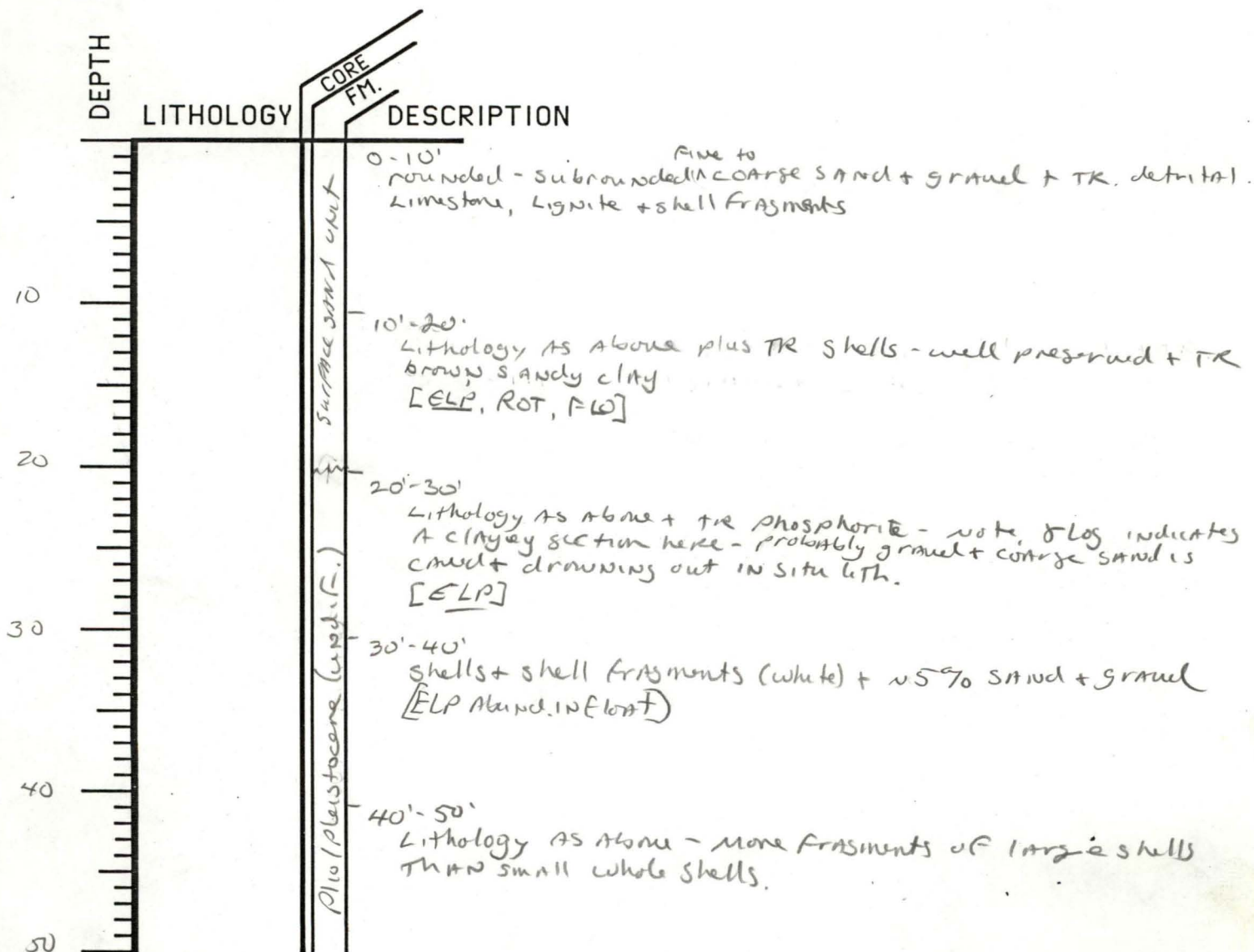

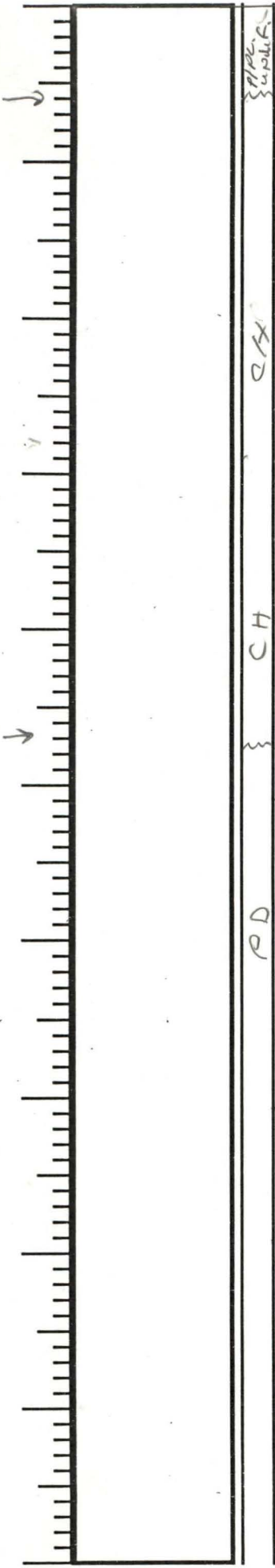
ELEVATION 52'

50'-60'  
40% grey sandy shelly moldic limestone -  
(Bear bluffs?)  
60% shell fragments + shells

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60'-70' TO white  
light gray + light brown sandy dense or moldic limestone, abundant,  
large shell fragments 5-10% AD, + TR cont. + TR phosphite  
crust - CAS + U Hydr

70'-80'  
Dense white sandy and/or moldic limestone - good C.H.

80'-90'  
Lithology AS Above

90'-100'  
brown dense sandy more + less moldic limestone +  
cream white limestone + shells. + TR phosphite

100'-110'  
light to dark grey very sandy + moderately moldic  
limestone.

110'-120'  
Lithology AS Above + cream colored moldic limestone with  
pale orange stained vugs. (seen in "water" well a few miles west)

120'-130'

130'-140'  
Lithology AS Above + TR oyster frags
