

Dear Senator Etheridge;

We wish to advise that on August 12th.1947 we abandoned and plugged our A.C.Lindley well no.1. As you know we first dug to granite in one hole and then for meticulous testing purposes shifted to the west 25 ft. and drilled and cored a second hole down to 2416 ft. Both holes were plugged with cement plug from 600 ft to within 20.ft. of surface and at request of land owner pipe was set and flowing well remains.

Enclosed please find electric log of the first hole completed.
