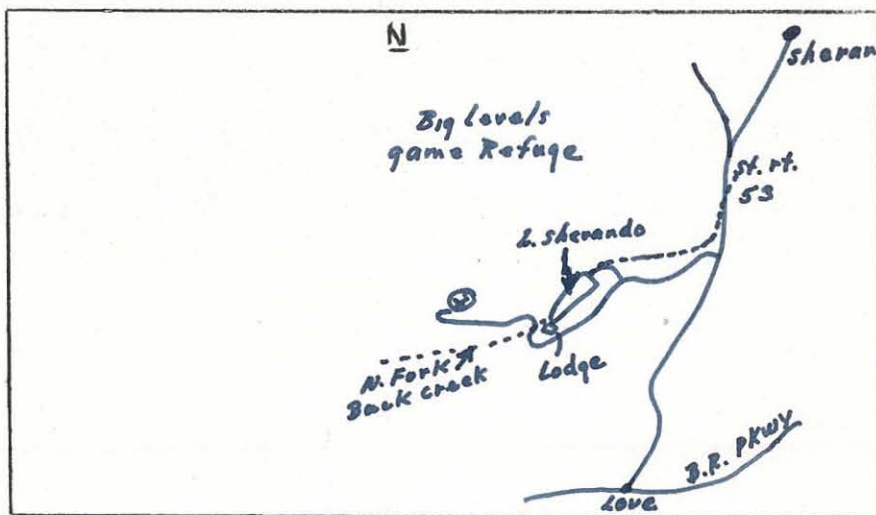


Log # 45 W # — County Augusta - 189 Date October 19, 1960
