200-240 Sand - light olive gray (5Y 5/2); very sparse clay; medium, subangular, well sorted; 30% fine glauconite; 1% fine shell fragments; forams - Siphogenerina, Pyrulina; echinoderm spines; mica.

240-260 Sand - light and dark gray; 50% glauconite; medium to coarse, subangular, moderate sorting; forams - Robulus; 1% shell fragments; garnet.

260-280 Sand - light and dark gray, moderate clay; 50% glauconite; fine to coarse, subangular, moderate sorting; 3%+ fine shell fragments; forams - Robulus; mica.

280-360 Sand - olive gray (5Y 4/1); abundant clay; 50% glauconite; fine to coarse, subangular, moderate sorting; 1% fine shell fragments; forams; mica.

360-380 Sand - light and dark gray; moderate ^{light brown} clay; 50% glauconite; fine to medium, subangular, moderate sorting; ~~argillaceous~~ mica.
