with sub-rounded quartz grains. (bedrock at 20 feet)
27-36 Shale as above
36-44 Shale, dark gray - black, some calcite seams (water 38-44)
water clear, sulphur tast & odor - temperature 55°C

REMARKS

When water was struck it came immediately up in the casing to within 6 inches of surface and remained for 12 hours. Water level then dropped to 4 feet below surface. Shortly there after it was noted that a well 300 feet away suddenly developed a rank sulphur taste.
