0-10	No sample.
10-20	Limestone - dark gray, almost black, fine grained, abundant white calcite veins, minor ferruginous quartz and clay, minor quartz pebbles.
20-30	As above - less calcite.
30-40	As above - slight increase of calcite, minor clay layers.
40-50	Limestone - dark gray almost black, fine grained, with abundant white vein calcite, minor black claystone, minor brown clay nodules.
50-60	As above - with very minor gray clay.
60-70	As above - no clays.
70-80	As above - with one piece of quartz from a silicified zone that has since been leached.
80-90	Limestone - dark gray almost black, fine grained with abundant white vein calcite, very minor brown shaly limestone.
90-100	As above - slightly lighter, no shaly limestone, very minor brown silicious fragments.
100-110	Limestone - dark gray, slightly bluish, fine grained, minor calcite veins, very minor silty limestone.
110-120	As above - slight increase of vein calcite.
120-130	Limestone - dark gray almost black, fine grained, thin bedded, minor white vein calcite, minor quartz aggregates.
130-140	As above - less vein calcite, no quartz.
140-150	Limestone - dark gray, fine grained, minor vein calcite, very minor quartz aggregates and ferruginous clay concretions.
