- 0-10 Sand- yellowish-gray; medium to coarse grained; subangular to rounded; well sorted; quartz; 15% glauconite; 2% shell fragments; some feldspar; few echinoid spines.
- 10-20 As above except salt and pepper; 20% glauconite; no feldspar.
- 20-30 Sand- yellowish-gray; medium grained; subangular to subrounded; well sorted; quartz; 7% glauconite; 2% shell fragments; few echinoid spines.
- 30-40 As above plus some fine grains; 5% shell fragments; few opaques.
- 40-50 Sand- yellowish-gray; fine to medium grained; subangular to subrounded; moderately well sorted; quartz; 3% shell fragments; 2% glauconite; few echinoid spines.
- 50-60 Shell fragments- white, medium gray; slightly clayey; some quartz sand; 98% shell fragments; quartz.
- 60-70 Shell fragments- white, medium gray; abundant sand; medium grained; subangular to subrounded; well sorted; 75% shell fragments; quartz; some glauconite; few flakes of muscovite.
- 70-80 As above except moderate sand.
- 80-90 As above except slightly sandy.
- 90-100 Shell fragments- light olive gray, white; moderate silt; abundant sand; medium grained; subangular to subrounded; well sorted; 70% shell fragments; quartz; some glauconite; few echinoid spines; muscovite; ostracode.
- 100-105 Sand- light olive gray; slightly clayey; moderate silt; fine to medium grained; subangular to subrounded; moderately well sorted; quartz; 10% shell fragments; some glauconite; some echinoid spines; few flakes of muscovite; forams rare (inc. Quinqueloculina).
- 105-115 As above except no clay; few echinoid spines; no forams.
