- 0-25 Gray schist, containing gray transparent quartz and coarse opaque gray rounded quartz grains which appear to be from the original sediment, also dark streaks that are probably biotite, some weathering. Some cleavage is slaty. (Sample probably taken at 25'.)
- 25-45 Same as above, unweathered.
- 45-65 Same.
- 65-85 Same with a few pyrite flakes.
- 85-105 Same with pyrite.
