0-15	Limestone - dark gray, finely crystalline, silty, hard, interbedded with light gray soft silty limestone, trace of iron stains on a few fragments (top of bedrock in this interval)
15-30	Limestone - dark gray, finely crystalline, hard, interbedded with light gray soft silty limestone, traces of vein calcite
30-45	Limestone - dark gray, finely crystalline, hard, lesser amount of soft gray limestone, some fine-vein calcite, trace of pyrite
45-60	As above
60-75	Limestone - dark gray, finely crystalline, hard, veins of calcite, small amount of interbedded light gray soft silty limestone
75-90	As above
90-105	As above
105-120	As above
120-128	Clay - yellowish brown, silty, non-calcareous, some dark gray limestone with small calcite veins
